■ When the request came through to CEF for a training event in Chester, it was an answer to prayer, knowing that I would be relocating to that area. At the end of June, Steve & Rachel Ball (from CEF East London) and myself had the privilege of running a Training Day at Freedom Church, Chester.

Newly appointed to lead the Children's Ministry at Freedom Church, Carol Wright was keen to organise further training for the





church and wider community. We had a wonderful welcome; there was a real sense of excitement and new beginnings for many who attended. In preparation, some members of the church took CEF Britain's online course, EQUIP, which laid a foundation for the training day.

The day was filled with a varied programme of 7 sessions, including 'Interactive Teaching', 'Preparing

a Bible Lesson', and 'Effective Memory Work', to name a few! One of the highlights of the day was Rachel's session using the Wordless Book to aid 'Counselling a child for Salvation.' We paired up and practised this technique. Afterwards, a pastor from Zimbabwe stated that when he returns to Zimbabwe, he will be taking the wordless book with him to share with children there. Wonderful!

We were greatly encouraged that those who attended had a clear desire to reach the children and young people of their communities. Their commitment to serving the Lord through children's ministry shone through their conversations and eagerness to engage enthusiastically with the whole training day. What a blessing!

Getting started and keeping going!

Are you getting started in teaching the Bible to children? Are you looking for a refresher to encourage you to keep on teaching the Bible to children? Sometimes some extra training really helps us to get started and sometimes some extra training reminds us why we got ourselves on the rota to teach the church children on Sundays!

CEF prioritises training because it helps us to teach the Bible well. Training gives fresh ideas and encourages us to keep going.

Are you interested?

CEF training can be accessed as a church group or as an individual. Equip is our online starter course (can also be taken as a refresher). In the comfort of your own home there are training videos to watch with notes (you can print these). Altogether there are six videos that cover different aspects of teaching children the Bible. There is also the bonus of meeting with others via zoom to chat over the ideas shared in the videos

and to encourage one another. The zoom meet ups are hosted and led by a CEF staff member. CEF runs this course each quarter so get in touch if you would like to register your interest. (info@cefbritain.org) This starter/refresher is completely free.

We also offer a longer online course, **Teaching Children Effectively Level**

1. This is a more in depth course with opportunities for participants to do some practical work. You will have the chance to teach a Memory Verse and teach a Bible Lesson. Currently this course is available online (contact info@cefbritain.org for dates) but can be held in person where there is a CEF Staff member. There is a charge for this course. The cost covers all the notes and teaching materials needed.

Making the most of the Paris Olympics

ow do you preach the Gospel to 11 million children in a country where 51% of the population say they are atheists and are proud of it? In a country where it is increasingly difficult to organise open air clubs?

In 2024, the Lord is giving us a wonderful opportunity with the Olympic Games to be held in Paris this summer.

Since January, a "sports day" kit has been available for churches to organise a one-day club. We are encouraged by the number of kits requested (around one hundred) and pray that each one will be transformed into a concrete club project!

We presented the kit by zoom and around a hundred people took part to find out more about its contents. We're delighted.

130,000 packs have been ordered for mass distribution. The pack contains the Gospel of Luke with an introduction by Eric Liddell and one of the CEF booklets for children (Olympics version).

Some churches distributed this while the Olympic flame was passing through their town.

Thank you for your prayers in support of these actions, which will continue this summer.

We are grateful for the 11 Irish young people who are joining the CEF France team for a week of evangelism during the Olympic Games in Paris. From 1 to 8 August, we will be offering 'sports day' clubs





in churches across Paris, distributing to letterboxes in the town where the national office is based (Wissous) and also trying to do some outdoor activities.

To reach children, we see that it's important to reach the whole family. 2 activities proposed by CEF France are working well:

- The "1001 bricks" weekends, which combine a day of lego building with a service/ inauguration on the Sunday for the whole family.
- Open-air "wood path" with families from working-class neighbourhoods. A trail with wooden games stands and stands for discovering the story of Jesus with wooden elements: the manger, a boat, the cross).

As outdoor clubs are difficult to set up, we have developed camps and day camps. It is through this ministry that we now reach the most children during the year.

For all these actions, we have a team of 15 wokers. Many only work parttime. May the Lord use us as he wills and we ask the Lord to send new labourers into the harvest.
