I read this recently from a book by Warren Wiersbe. Please read Psalm 2.

"God hears (v1-3). He hears the raging of the nations. What do they want? Freedom from God! But the way to real freedom is by submission and not by rebellion.

God laughs (v4). Puny man does not worry God with all his noise and threats. God is on the throne and has everything in control. When the world's noise frightens you, turn to the Lord and let him take over (Acts3:23-31).

God speaks (5-12). God the Father announces that his king is enthroned in the heavenly Zion where the nations cannot touch him. God the Son announces that the nations are his, so their rebellion is futile (v7-9). Finally, God the Spirit invites the rebels to submit and be blessed instead of destroyed (v10-12).

Over the noise of the nations listen for the assuring voice of God."

May this bless and encourage us as we come to pray for the work of CEF in Western Europe during these months. May the Lord change many children and young people from rebels to those who submit to him. May he call many to proclaim the gospel so this can happen for his glory.

	our faithful prayer and financial supporters on how God has blessed the ministry, especially over the summer months. Pray that God will challenge and encourage those present.
6	Andrew & Beulah McMullan: We praise God for the group of men travelling to the Vendas Novas camp centre, Portugal to carry out maintenance work this week. Please pray for safety in travel, for unity within the group and that God will give them the needed skills to complete the work.
	Stephen & Grace Chambers: Please pray for Stephen as he teaches the 'Biblical Basis' classes at CMLC in Germany this week. Also pray for Grace and the children at home in Northern Ireland.
7	Switzerland: Thank the Lord for the churches and individuals who have responded to our letters and ordered the "Do you know the King?" booklet and Wondersurf-Flyer (3000 pcs ordered up to September 25). Pray for more orders, but also specifically pray that the Lord will help with the distribution and prepare the hearts of the children, parents and all recipients. The booklets will be distributed on markets, in the streets, at craft afternoons, personal encounters etc.
8	Finland: Please pray for us as we ponder what to do with training. Two TCE 1 courses planned for this year were cancelled because we only got 1–2 registrations for each.
9	Portugal: We give thanks to the Lord for the team retreat we were able to have last September in the Azores, and for the closing of the celebrations of 75 years of ministry in Portugal with the churches there.
10	Germany: We thank the Lord for sending us two young ladies who will work as trainees for Wondersurf for one year. They will first attend the CMLC and then start the work with Wondersurf in January 2025. We ask the Lord that they will stay.
11	Spain: We thank God very much for the 5 Spanish students who are participating in the IOT course in Sibiu. We hope that it will be a great blessing for them and of help for the training ministry in Spain.

12 Oct Education: Praise God for His help during two busy weeks at the IOT 1 course in Sibiu. Pray for everyone as they travel home today. Pray that God will use these newly trained TCE 1 instructors to train many more Good News Club teachers. Sweden: Pray for our TCE1 course in Helsingborg. Pray for the participants that they will be well equipped to reach more boys and girls. 13 Ireland: 13th-20th October is our Autumn week of prayer. We are very thankful for many who remember the children and young people of Ireland and further afield 14 Estonia: Praise the Lord for great tools to reach children of today. Praise the Lord for wondersurf.com in Estonian and pray for good content. Multimedia: Today the Literature Survey classes start at the CMLC in Ireland. Pray that the students will learn how to effectively use CEF literature in the ministry to reach and teach children. Pray that maybe some of them will help develop this ministry in respective languages. 15 Education: Pray that the Zoom meetings planned on the 15th & 16th related to the multimedia ministry in Europe and training ministries in western Europe will be profitable and fruitful. Multimedia: Today and tomorrow, the Multimedia Advisory Group meets to discuss the current and future projects. Ireland from 18th-28th to teach at CMLC and speak about the work in Greece in a couple of churches. May God help them with the language and use them for His glory. 19 Portugal: We give thanks to God for the brothers and sisters who have contributed financially and for those who have given of their time and technical expertise to come and help with the renovation of the camp centre facilities. We ask the Lord to open doors for CEF to reach the children there with the Gospel. 24 Ireland: Leadership will be conducting visits to all our Local Committees over the next few weeks. We praise God for faithful committee members and please pray for those areas who do not have a local worker, but the committee are maintaining ministry on an ongoing basis. 25 Lithuania: Praise the Lord for 140 children plus their families who actively participated in the program at the library and in the park in eastern Lithuania (Anykščiai and Rokiškis). Praise the Lord for the Christian choir VALIO to partner with us in this outreach. 26 Spain: For all the contacts, meetings and promotions that are being carried out throughout Spain to encourage churches to hold Christmas parties. Also for the online seminar for all of Spain that will be held today. 27 Britain: Praise God for calling Philip & Denise Annett to accept the ministry role of Training Coordinators for CEF Britain. Pray for wisdom for them as they prepare to teach the next online TCE 1 course, starting Module 1 in October. Pray that this will enable more volunteers to learn how to reach children in Britain with the gospel. Pray for some to consider further training with the CMLC course next year. 28 Lithuania: Pray for a volunteer to help with the multimedia items in Lithuanian language. 29 Stephen & Grace Chambers: please pray for the 11 countries of NW Europe – pray the Lord will send out labourers into his harvest field.
